Warsaw, Poland: Youth Citizens Workshop for Youth Workers

Dates: May 27 - May 29, 2024

Location: Warsaw, Poland

Participants: 50 Youth Workers from Across Europe

From May 27 to May 29, the vibrant city of Warsaw became a hub of innovation and collaboration as it hosted the Youth Citizens Workshop for Youth Workers. This three-day event focused on empowering youth workers with the knowledge and skills necessary to establish Youth Advisory Committees dedicated to peace, inclusion, and active participation.



Key Highlights of the Youth Participation Mobility in Poland were:

- Participants engaged in hands-on workshops where they explored best practices for creating and managing Youth Advisory Committees. These committees are designed to serve as vital platforms for young people to voice their opinions, contribute to policy-making, and drive community initiatives focused on peace and inclusion.
- Youth workers participated in collaborative discussions, sharing experiences and strategies for fostering youth engagement in their respective communities. These discussions provided a unique opportunity for cross-cultural exchange and the development of innovative approaches to common challenges.

Bucharest, Romania: Training on Youth Engagement for a Peaceful Participatory Europe

Dates: April 27 - April 29, 2024

Location: Bucharest, Romania

Participants: 50 Youth Workers from Across Europe

Bucharest was the setting for a transformative month-long training program focused on engaging youth in building a Peaceful Participatory Europe. From April 27 to May 29, 50 dedicated youth workers from various European countries gathered in Romania's capital to enhance their skills in youth engagement and peacebuilding.

Key Highlights of the Youth Participation Mobility in Romania were:

- The training covered a wide range of topics crucial for youth engagement, including leadership development, communication strategies, conflict resolution, and civic participation. Each module was designed to equip participants with the practical skills needed to inspire and mobilize youth in their communities.

The impact of this training is expected to ripple across Europe as participants return to their home countries to implement their newly acquired skills and knowledge.
